

## Summary of InKind Donations Programs

**Home Depot Program** - Not a good match for PHSSA reasons outlined below

- Not allowed to pick and choose items needed.
- Must pick up pallet from local Home Depot within 48 hours of notification with own vehicle. They do not deliver. So we would need quick access to a either a loading dock height truck, or truck with a lift gate. Could get by with a panel truck but loading and unloading would be time consuming.
- Items can not be sold, traded, auctioned or used in raffle. So if we picked up a pallet worth of shower doors, PHSSA would be responsible for them.

### **Good360 Program**

This program is interesting. Basically a catalog of products that are available that members can request. Browsing it today found some matches for our needs as a school such as [Arts and Crafts](#) but necessarily in relation to facilities. There is some [Technology](#) and [Building Supplies](#) that could come in handy but would need to have some one closer to our list of needs to evaluate. If possible I would recommend we sign up for these program, provided we meet the following criteria and it can be done online.

- Have an employer identification number (EIN) for your charity
- Be a currently registered 501(c)(3) public charity
- Have filed the Form 990 with the IRS within the past 2 years.

Schools are allowed but if we haven't filled out a Form 990 we would need to speak with them directly. I asked a rep how many school were part GIK and he said that they did have schools he couldn't give me a number. I have a feeling that our application would not be an easy online process but I don't see anything on the GIK end that would prevent us from being accepted.

Possible issue could be there is an administrative fee that covers shipping/handling that would vary per order. In talking with a rep that fee could be 65 for a large carton and to \$700 for a pallet but very often the fees are lower. I'm not sure how that would fit into RPS purchasing regulations or even if they would apply to PHSSA.

### **Dell Program**

The Dell Program is run by distribution centers, so have a separate application process.
